Notes to the accounts

The financial statement has been prepared (1) in accordance with the Charity Commission Statement of Recommended Practice together with applicable accounting standards (2) on a cash basis and (3) under the historical cost convention. Income is recognised when it is due. Direct income relates to the promotion of the society's objects through the use of the Theatre. Grants, interest and tax recoverable are accounted for when received. Hire income is recognised when the hire is due. Expenditure is accounted for on receipt of the invoice. Figures are shown net of VAT; within the Partial Exemption regulation some Input Tax was recovered. The Queen Mother Theatre is built on land which is leased from North Herts District Council for a term of 99 years from 1983; the rent for the whole term was paid then. The Trustees discontinued depreciation in 2002.

EXAMINER'S REPORT

3,531 Much Ado about Nothing

This report on the accounts of the Bancroft Players for the year ended 30 June 2015. As the charity's trustees, you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts; you consider that the audit requirement of Section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the Act) does not apply. It is my responsibility to state, on the basis of procedures specified in the General Directions given by the Charity Commissioners under Section 145 of the Act, whether particular matters have come to my attention.
